The gallery is open weekends only in May-June and September-October, and 7 days a week in July and August. The first half will be May, Jun and Jul; the second half, Aug, Sep, and Oct

As a guest artist you will have the following benefits:

1. An opportunity to exhibit and sell your artwork in an attractive gallery with a good location.
2. Low cost fee (\$100) and commission rate (30%).
3. An opportunity to interact with other artists and the general public.
4. Advertising and promotion through social media, printed materials and radio ads
5. All the normal benefits of BPSA membership, including monthly meetings; occasional workshops and projects; newsletter, and discounts at certain art supply stores

As a guest artist you will have the following responsibilities:

1. The Co-op will display ORIGINAL artwork only, produced by the guest artist.
2. Artwork must be for sale, except for one piece which is allowed to be Not for Sale (NFS).
3. All work displayed must adhere to the Guidelines as set out by the Co-op.
4. Each artist is responsible for carrying insurance on their artwork.
5. All artists are expected to conduct themselves in a professional, friendly and cooperative manner.
